

Oregon Student Assistance Commission Scholarships (OSAC)

OSAC is an organization that administers around 350 scholarships available to Oregon students. Pacific High School students are eligible for 36 of these scholarships and they are listed below. The application is available at www.getcollegefunds.org and the deadline is March 1, 2008 (Early Bird deadline is February 15, 2008)

Pacific High School – Alumni: For graduating Pacific High School Seniors.

Pacific High School – Charlie Jensen Memorial: Graduating Pacific High School Seniors who have taken at least one year of music.

ACEC – American Council of Engineering Companies of Oregon: Students seeking to enter the consulting engineering field.

Ahmad and Zafar Foundation: Open to Female English Majors with a 3.50+ GPA.

Benjamin Franklin/Edith Green: Students entering a four-year public school only.

Blacktail Deer: Students with a Commitment to managing wildlife. Requires a 250 word an extra essay.

Byrd: Open to students with a high school GPA of 3.85+ and a 1300 Math +Verbal SAT.

Campbell: Open to females with a 2.75+ GPA. Oregon four-year college only. Requires a one page essay on the sport of golf.

Connacher: Descendants of POWs only.

Crawford: Open to students with a 3.50+ GPA and proof of US citizenship. Not open to students majoring in law, medicine, music, teaching, or theology.

Darfur Humanitarian Essay: Requires a 350-500 word essay on the crisis in Darfur.

Department of Human Services: For Students currently in foster care or in an independent living program. For students entering Oregon public colleges only.

Diermann: For students majoring in music, performing arts, accounting, or sales (computer, software).

DREAM for Foster Youth: For students who have been in foster care.

Early Bird Award: Open to students who submit an OSAC application by February 15, 2008.

Ford Scholars Program: Must be planning to work toward a BA at a nonprofit Oregon college. 3.00+ GPA required.

Hasson Essay Announcement: Requires a 3-4 page essay on Credit in the 21st Century. Separate process – do not send to OSAC.

Huffstutter Family Stylist: Students studying cosmetology, beauty, barbering, or hairdressing.

Jackson Foundation Journalism: For journalism majors.

Jackson-White: For students whose parents serve or have served in the US armed forces and resided in Oregon at time of enlistment. 3.75+ GPA required.

Kaiser Permanente Dental Assistant: Open to students enrolling in a full-time accredited dental assistant programs at Blue Mountain, Central Oregon, Chemeketa, Lane, Linn-Benton, Portland Community College, or Concorde Career Institute.

NLN Ella McKinney: Nursing programs accredited by the NLNAC. (Chemeketa, PCC, Umpqua and Walla Walla College (Oregon branch).

Oregon Scholarship Fund: Students enrolling in Oregon community colleges.

Osborne: For students enrolling in Oregon cosmetology, beauty, barbering, hairdressing schools.

Portland Women's Club: For females with 3.00+ GPA. 250 – 300 word essay required.

Professional Land Surveyors of Oregon: Student in programs leading to careers in land surveying. Requires an extra essay.

Roy: For Engineering students with a high school GPA of 2.75+.

Schmidt: Open to nursing students intending to pursue careers in geriatric care.

Bandon Submarine Cable Council: Preference to children of Cable Council members and fishermen residing in Coos county but open to others.

Croddy/Edgar: For dependents of persons affiliated with Joint Council of Teamsters #37.

Davies: For dependents of eligible employees of US Bank.

Emmons: Open to children or grandchildren of owners or employees, employed three+ years, who are regular members of the Oregon Refuse and Recycling Assoc.

Jackson-ODOT: Open to dependents of employees or retirees of ODOT or Parks and Recreation department. Two essays required.

Merchant Marine: Open to descendants (children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews) of Merchant Marine or US Navy Armed Guard veterans. Documentation required.

Oregon Dungeness Crab Commission: For dependents of licensed Oregon Dungeness Crab fishermen or crew.

Oregon Salmon Commission: For dependents of licensed commercial Oregon troll salmon permit fishermen.
