This position is a TEMPORARY 0.66 FTE (5.3 hours per day, Monday - Friday) K - 6 music/fine arts teaching position located at Driftwood Elementary School in the Port Orford - Langlois School District 2CJ.

This position starts in August 2022 and is only for the 2022 - 23 school year.

The position will offer music and/or fine arts instruction to students in grades K - 6.

We seek a creative and passionate teacher who has a sense of humor and genuine love for working with all students in teaching the arts.

The successful candidate will be able to:

1. Use multiple genres of music and/or other fine arts areas as resources to teach music and/or fine arts

education.

2. Follow and implement national music standards for respective grade levels;

3. Instruct all students at their levels;

4. Demonstrate effective classroom management skills;

5. Contribute to the development, planning, and promotion of the music and/or fine arts component of the winter and spring community events as agreed upon with the school administration;

6. Manage and maintain inventory of school-owned instrument, music, and other inventory;

7. Establish positive relationships and partnerships with families, fellow musical colleagues, and the arts community within the school district and region.

8. Communicate with colleagues, administration, and parents/guardians in a clear and consistent manner, following district guidelines and protocols.

In addition, a successful applicant will have the ability to keep and maintain accurate attendance, academic, and behavior records, meet deadlines set forth by the school and district administration, and preserve a high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality when dealing with student, staff and/or parent information.

The district provides professional development opportunities both within the and outside of the district.

This position may include stipends for both student performances outside of school hours.

Teachers may transfer up to 10 years of experience. Please see current licensed contract for salary scale.

Extracurricular opportunities may be available for high school and/or junior high school sports and activities.

The Port Orford – Langlois School District is comprised of two locations: Driftwood Elementary School, which houses grades K – 6 located in Port Orford with a population of approximately 125 students, and Pacific High School, which houses grades 7 – 12 and is located seven miles north of Port Orford and seven miles south of Langlois that has a population of approximately 95 students.
