Dear Parents and Community:

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of our staff, students, and community. The CDC and OHA also recommend the use of masks for individuals at risk of health complication or who live with someone in a high – risk group even after restrictions have been lifted.

This school year, masks will continue to be **OPTIONAL** to wear within our buildings, buses and on district property. If a staff or student wants a mask, the district will provide one if asked.

We know that there will be staff and students who choose to continue wearing masks. Our district will support these decisions and I continue to ask that we honor and respect those who choose to continue to wear a mask while indoors and avoid making fun at, or teasing, those who do.

Staff or students who have tested positive for COVID – 19 will be required to quarantine for five (5) days from day of the positive test and will then be required to wear a mask for another five (5) days, which could include time in school. As always, we do ask that if your student is showing signs of any communicable illness, please keep them home until those symptoms subside.

The district will provide COVID tests to any family who may need one. Please contact either Pacific or Driftwood’s front office to request a test.

This school year, OHA and ODE again require any staff member, coach, volunteer, or guest who come in contact with our students while in school be fully vaccinated or show proof of a negative COVID test 72 hours prior to the event. Please contact our schools’ front office if you have any questions on what needs to be shown to fulfill this requirement.
